Tricky homophones:

effect (to accomplish)

Example: Rachel wants to save the butterfly from extinction, so she will write Congress to effect change.

Affect (to influence)

Example: No matter how hard Rachel tries, she cannot affect Joe's opinion that the blue butterfly is a silly creature.
